This National Historic Landmark has been faithfully restored to its 1920s origins and enhanced with exhibits focusing on Evanston history. Note: there are stairs. The Wilmette History Museum is located in the former Gross Point Village Hall. Built in 1896, the Gross Point Village Hall is a lovely two-story, late-Victorian structure. During your visit you will learn the history of Native Americans on the North Shore, local legends, and step in the historical Gross point jail cell. 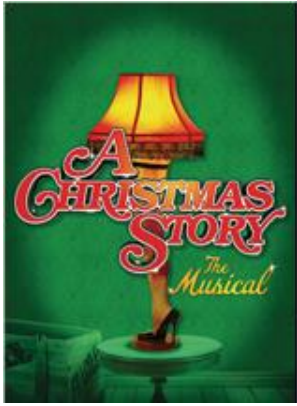

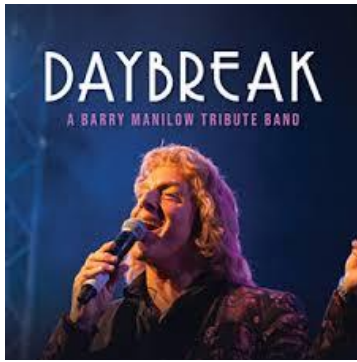
